Where are we in God's time line of events? You have probably asked that because of the things that have been happening around the world and especially

things that affect us here close to home. Wars and rumors of wars, weather crises, global health issues, our economy and the seriousness of the coming elections have believers and non-believers thinking about the future. God has given us strong clues and warnings about the conditions when Christ returns. Is the end near? In case of emergency what is the plan?

What is in your emergency plan? Do you stock up on supplies and buy a motor scooter to save enough to survive? Where do you move to avoid heavy rains or hurricanes? Is it a place where floods and fires will miss you? Have you researched to see if there have ever been tornados or lightning storms in the area? There are so many variables. And answering these questions turns out to be the wrong safeguards anyway. Our shelter has always been the Lord's protection and that is consistent in the past, present and the future.

One thing is sure, God is in control. I take comfort in that

knowledge and the fact that He told us beforehand that these things must come to pass. It is like being told ahead of time so we can react in trust. If we know we can trust His protection we can stay at our task. (Ps 4: 5-8) *Offer right sacrifices, and put your trust in the Lord. There are many who say, "Who will show us some good? Lift up the light of your face upon us, O Lord!" You have put more joy in my heart than they have when their grain and wine abound. In peace I will both lie down and sleep; for you alone, O Lord, make me dwell in safety.*

Our weapon against the world's turmoil is the peace that God gives to those who trust Him. (Isaiah 30:15) *For thus said the Lord God, the Holy one of Israel, "In returning and rest you shall be saved; In quietness and in trust shall be your strength." But you were unwilling.*

It is sometimes difficult to hold that quiet confidence when things of the world are raging around you. God's warning in Isaiah amounted to "you were unwilling" to settle down, focus and believe. I have found a prayer by Peter Marshall that has helped me when I am in danger of following the world's lead and dropping my shield. As I share

CHARLES W. COLSON is heard weekdays at 7:30 a.m. on the broadcast “Breakpoint”. His incredible experience in govern-



ment and law has brought him to a point where he is considered one of America’s leading authorities on the causes of and responses to crime. In addition to his Breakpoint commentary, he is a syndicated columnist, international speaker, author of 24 books and founder of Prison Fellowship. He received the Templeton Prize for Progress in Religion in 1993. The 1 million dollar prize which Colson accepted on behalf of Prison Fellowship was added to Prison Fellowship’s Endowment Fund. Over 30 years ago, Chuck Colson was not thinking about reaching out to prison inmates or reforming the U.S. penal system. In the mid 70s Colson was known as the White House “hatchet man”, a man feared by even the most powerful politicians during his four years of service to President Nixon. When news leaked of Colson’s conversion to Christianity the Boston Globe reported, “If Mr. Colson can repent of his sins, there just has to be hope for everybody”. Colson would agree. He admits he was guilty of political “dirty tricks” and willing to do almost anything for the cause of his president and his party. Colson has now built Prison Fellowship into the world’s largest prison outreach, servicing the spiritual and practical needs of prisoners in 93 countries, including the U.S. Colson’s vision has grown to include ministering to the families of prisoners, to ex-prisoners, to victims of crime, and reforming the criminal justice system.
